As we celebrate the new year, we are most grateful to those — like you — who provide financial support to the Wichita Public Library Foundation. Your contributions make a real difference in the number of services and programs the library can provide our community. In 2019 more than 5,400 programs were offered throughout the library system — a significant increase over 2018.

The focus of 2019 was to identify key strategies to increase the capacity of the WPLF to provide more funding to meet the increased demand for library programs and services. Here are a few of our successes. The WPLF:

- Implemented new donor software that will help in gathering and analyzing information about prospective, current and former donors.
- Successfully transitioned to a new CEO/president.
- Hired a new part-time employee.
- ❖ Worked with the board on a successful year-end fundraising initiative.
- * Received a seven-figure estate gift to boost our endowment.
- ❖ Began bi-annual fundraising appeals, with the Library Day of Giving occurring in April and Imagine the Possibilities in November/December.
